

Open Enrollment Begins April 1st - 6am 2010/2011 School Year

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

How Many Spots Will You Have?

- Availability in certain grade levels will be very limited this coming year. We highly encourage you to be here early to put in your student's application.
- **DUE TO THE TREMENDOUS DEMAND** – we are expanding our Kindergarten, 6th grade, and 8th grade with additional classes.

What Do I Need To Bring With Me?

- You may download the 2010/2011 application and bring it with you completed.
- **YOU DO NOT NEED** to bring any other documentation with you at this time – **BUT YOU WILL NEED TO HAVE THEIR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER.**

When Will We Know If Our Student Has Been Accepted?

- We will receive applications from April 1st through June 15th at 4pm. On the 16th the applications will be pulled to fill any known openings we have.
- A letter will be mailed to all applicants informing them of whether they made the initial round of acceptance or are on the waiting list on June 16th.

If We Are Accepted – What Do We Do Then?

- Those receiving the letter informing them that they did make the initial round will need to begin the enrollment process immediately. To hold that spot for your student, you will have a limited amount of time to get your enrollment packet back into us and complete the enrollment process of meeting with the principals, etc. All enrollment packages must be filled out and turned in along completing the enrollment process no later than June 29th. If that deadline is not met, your spot will be forfeited to another student on the waiting list.

How Does The Waiting List Work?

- All applications that do not make the initial round to fill known openings go onto a waiting list for a lottery pull. When an opening occurs in that grade level, all the applicant names are put into a bowl and one name is drawn for that opening. You are contacted immediately and must begin the enrollment process and complete it in a timely manner or your spot will be forfeited.

What Happens If All My Kids Don't Get In?

- TLCA strives to accommodate families. Unfortunately, sometimes one or more of the siblings may end up on a waiting list until we have space for them. Siblings do have priority and are moved to the top of the waiting list for placement.

Do You Offer Tours Of Your Campuses?

- Yes, by appointment only at the respective campus.

Can I Enroll Now?

- WE DO HAVE A FEW OPENINGS IN SOME GRADES AT THIS TIME. If you are considering moving your student to TLCA, this may be the time to make the move. Making the move now ensures a spot for your student next year.

Where Do We Need To Come On April 1st?

- LOOK FOR THE TENT ON APRIL 1ST!
- The following days we will have signage showing the way to where we are accepting applications. The basic location will be the elementary campus at 5687 Melrose or around the corner at the Administration Office, 5737 Stratford.

Can I Get An Application Now?

- Yes! You may print it out and bring it with you to save time that morning. Remember – we cannot accept any applications before April 1st for the 2010/2011 school year.

Can I Send The Application With Someone Else To Drop Off?

- TLCA looks strongly at parent participation and we require parents to fulfill certain requirements throughout the school year. We feel the best way to get off on the right start is for you to personally deliver the application or come by and fill one out. If you are currently living out of town, call the Registrar's office for additional information.
